



Anchoring Posts

Tools / Materials Needed:

- Anchor post (marked orange with two oval holes)
- Maclean Duckbill anchor
- Sledgehammer or post driver
- Pick or other long-handled tool that can be used for prying

1. Insert rebar or driving rod into receiving end of duckbill anchor
2. Beside anchor post on side with upper oval hole, at an angle perpendicular to the length of structure, drive duckbill downward and slightly angled toward the outside of the hoophouse
3. Continue driving anchor until cable loop is about two inches below the upper oval hole on anchor post
4. Pull out rebar from duckbill anchor
5. Insert the end of a pick (digging tool) into cable loop
6. Pry upward on cable loop to engage duckbill anchor
7. Insert rebar through cable loop and down through both oval holes in anchor post
2. Drive down rebar through cable loops and oval holes, leaving about six inches of rebar protruding out

Drive down duckbill anchor
alongside anchor post
