Full Installation!

This is going to be fun! We love building hoophouses. Sit back, make some lemonade, and watch your hoophouse be built!

You are buying your hoophouse and hiring us to completely install it for you. With that said, you're more than welcome to help with the process! *Learning key steps of how the structure is built will help you to maintain it through the years.*

There are a few things we need from you to make this process go extra smoothly:

- **Ready the site** — Clear the hoop site of debris, till up the perimeter, and prepare access so we can get as close as possible to the site with a truck and trailer
- **Prepare an area to build bows** — We'll need a reasonably flat area at least 30' x 30' to assemble bows before standing them
- **Be available and on-site when the build starts** — We need you to give final approval of the exact placement and tilt of the structure
- **Make a bathroom available** for our crew — everyone must heed the call of nature



If the weather turns against us, we may not be able to install your top poly due to high winds. While we have been fortunate through the years, we are not able to install top poly on every hoophouse we build. In this case you have a few options:

- **Do it yourself** — If you agree to install the overhead poly and wrap-up tasks yourself, we're happy to credit you \$250 toward your final invoice
- **Arrange for one or more of our lead builders to return** to help you and your crew install the top poly. Equipment travel costs and \$80/person/hour charged for on-site and all travel time
- **Arrange for our full crew to return** at the rates above. Depending on your timing needs, we may be able to schedule this with another job near your location, which saves on travel expenses.

After your hoophouse is built, you'll be receiving an invoice for your balance. We appreciate timely payment. If you have any questions about your hoophouse, how to grow in it, or anything else, please call us at 734-845-0079.
