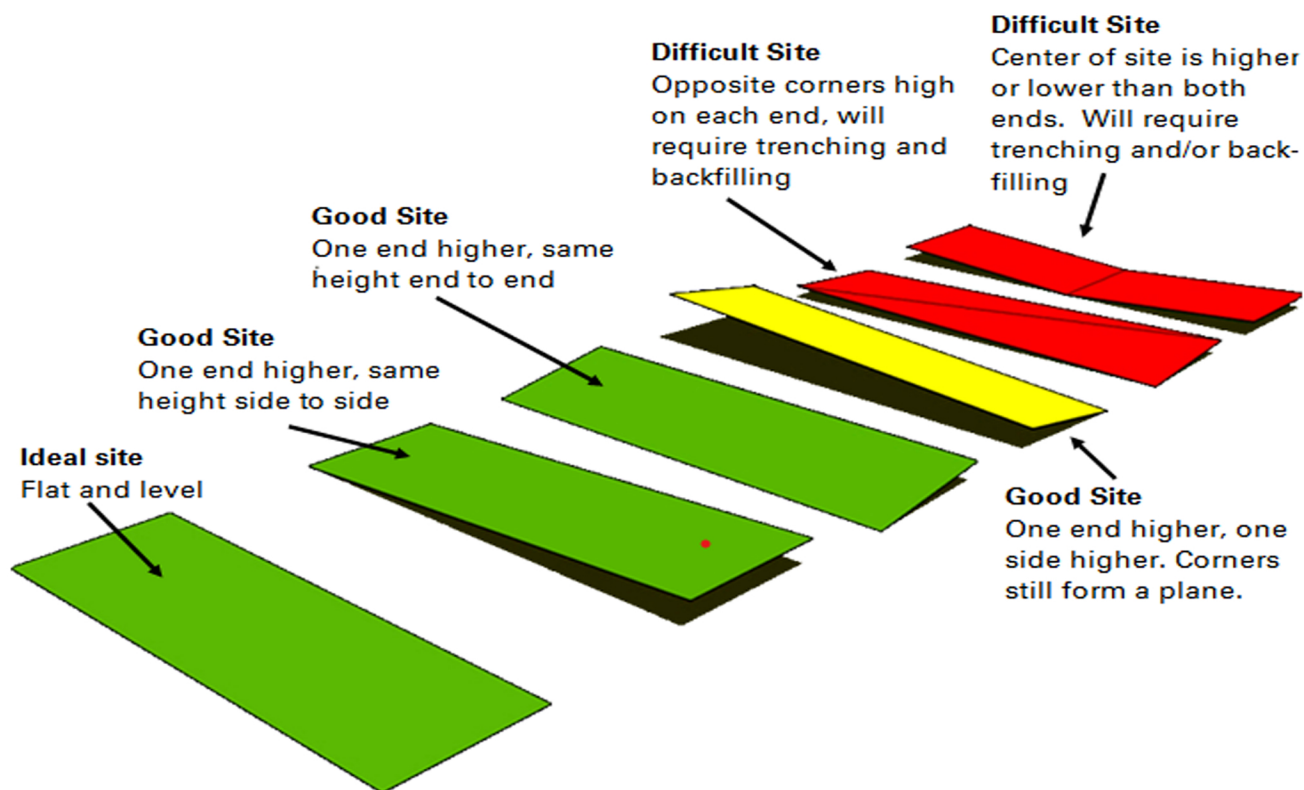


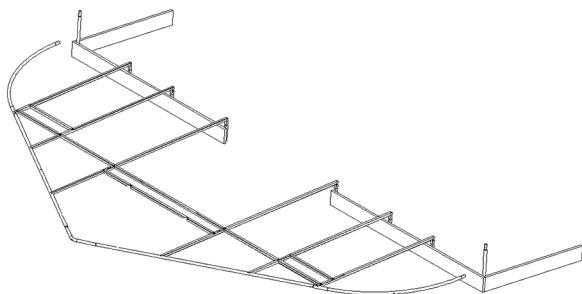
Site Selection

Facing the hoophouse in an east-west orientation will allow for optimal sunlight during winter months. A north-south orientation can work -- an efficient work flow at your farm is just as important.

Choose a flat site that is accessible for our trailer! If your site is not "bubble level", that's okay, but a flat site is important. A site with an uneven grade can require considerable trenching for baseboards and/or baseboards installed above the soil surface, requiring back-filling to eliminate the gap.



We ask for 15' of working area beyond the structure size on each end to accommodate endwall installation. This should be a reasonably level and smooth surface to provide a safe surface for ladder work at the endwalls.



We've built plenty of hoophouses on "bad" sites – just know that it will require more work!
