Starter Build!

This is going to be fun! There's nothing that brings us closer than working together.

You are buying your hoophouse and hiring two of our lead builders for four hours to help unload, set, your posts, and get the project started with you



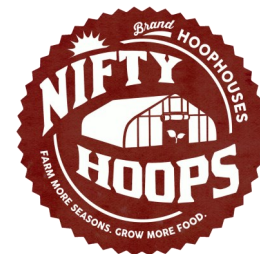
You should be prepared to make the best use of our builder's time. There are a few things you can do to make this go extra smoothly:

- **Ready the site** — Clear the hoop site of debris, till up the perimeter, and prepare access so we can get as close as possible to the site with a truck and trailer
- **Prepare an area to build bows** — We'll need a flat area at least 30' x 30' to build bows
- **Bring a couple other people** — Although it's more challenging to supervise a crew of people than if we have two builders on-site (as with our Community Build), we can still get a lot more done if we have a few more people to help unload, build and stand bows, attach purlins, etc.

Take photos — We'll be giving you a complete installation manual, and you can always refer to our video series (niftyhoops.com/support), but having your own photos of key steps in the build process can really help!

Our goal with a starter build is to:

- **Complete layout and post-setting** — We'll bring a laser transit and gas-powered post driver to make this go *much* more quickly
- **Stand at least six bows and an endwall**, complete with purlins, hipboards, and baseboards
- **Plumb the hoophouse** — Getting the structure standing up straight and properly braced gives you a solid foundation on which to build the rest of the structure
- **Answer any questions you might have** — Are you nervous about pulling poly? Running low-voltage wiring? Ask away!
